

Child is Ages 3, 4, or 5 and Attends Preschool

The child has an Early Childhood LRE Code:

Regular Early Childhood Setting = Any childcare setting containing 50% or more typical peers.
(Includes Head Start, Public or Private Preschool, Home Childcare, Daycare Center)

Child Attends At Least 10 Hours Per Week In The Regular Early Childhood Setting, and:

26 = Majority of special education services are provided in the regular early childhood classroom

- Identified students attending public community preschool

27 = Majority of special education services are provided in the special education setting

- Speech only

Child Attends Less Than 10 Hours Per Week In The Regular Early Childhood Setting, and:

28 = Majority of special education services are provided in a Gen Ed preschool classroom

- Gen Ed support from paraprofessional per IEP
- Preschool teacher provides services
- Push-in special education support

29 = Majority of special education services are provided in the special education setting

- Speech only

Child Does Not Attend a General Education Setting:

33 = Separate special education class: **Developmental preschool class**

34 = Student attends a separate school: **Indiana School for the Deaf or Blind**

35 = Student attends a residential facility and resides there: **Damar**

36 = Child does not attend public/private community preschool. Only receives walk-in services, provided in special ed setting: **Walk-In Speech**

37 = Homebound

38 = Child parentally placed in a private preschool. Includes only those preschools attached to a private elementary (*This code impacts funding. Make sure you are using correctly!!!)

At ACR, designate in IIEP notes that the child's LRE will change from an early-childhood code to a school-aged code. ex: 50, 51, 52 See reverse for school age LRE codes.

Child Attends K-12 OR is age 6 at Dec 1 count and attends Preschool

The child has a school-age LRE Code:

Child Attends a General Education Setting:

50 = Regular Class (in a regular classroom for 80% or more of the day)

- Attends gen ed classroom with or without support for at least 80% of the day
- May participate small amount of pull-out

51 = Resource Room (in a regular classroom for 40-79% of the day)

- Attends more intensive amount of pull-out instruction

Child Does Not Attend a General Education Setting:

52 = Separate Class (in a regular classroom for less than 40% of the day)

- Essential Skills Classroom

53 = Separate Day School Facility: Student attends school there

- Earlywood, Indiana School for the Deaf or the Blind

54 = Residential Facility: Students attends and resides there

- Damar

55 = Correctional Facility

56 = Parentally Placed in Private School (*This code impacts funding. Make sure you are using correctly!!!)

57 = Homebound/Hospital Placement
