Covered Occupational Therapy School Based Services

Occupational Therapy IEP Services that should be reported into GoGlaimTM include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Planning and directing exercises and programs to improve sensor-integration and motor functioning at a level of performance neurologically appropriate for a student's stage of development.
- 2. Analyzing, selecting, and adapting functional exercise to achieve and maintain a student's optimal functioning in daily living tasks and to prevent further disability.

OT Provider Qualifications

Occupational therapy must be provided by:

- 1. A Registered Occupational Therapist
- 2. A Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant acting within his/her scope of practice, under the direct supervision of the Registered Occupational Therapist

General Service Requirements

- Physician/other Medical Professional orders or referrals must be obtained upon initiation of service and annually thereafter
- An Individualized Education Plan (IEP) that specifies scope, frequency, and duration that correlate with the professional recommendations
- General strengthening exercise program(s) for recuperative purposes are not covered.
- Passive range of motion services are not covered as the only or primary modality for therapy.
- Evaluations must be conducted by a registered Occupational Therapist. The registered Occupational Therapist must also develop and maintain the plan of care.
- An Occupational Therapy Assistant may not initiate, develop, submit, or change a student's plan of care.
